My first few weeks back in the fall I was excited to begin our Cheat Mountain salamander surveys (such fun!) and attend a CMS workshop to further my knowledge about the Cheat Mountain salamander as well as other salamander species in the area. I was also introduced to several professionals within the environmental field, including others in the Fish and Wildlife Service, Forest Service, DNR, and environmental contractors. AFNHA AmeriCorps has been awarded a competitive AmeriCorps grant for 34 members for the 2021–2022 term, plus an additional 8 positions just awarded from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds. In addition, the ARPA funding will raise member stipends to \$16,000 a year. This gives us a total program of 42 member positions, our largest ever. Because these additional funds were just awarded, we are still recruiting for a number of positions. While the new term starts September 8, we will continue recruiting through the fall until all positions are filled. THESE MUST BE FILLED BY
